Program History

- Created in response to the State of Minnesota's legislation (Stat. 216B.1641), passed in 2013, to provide for community solar gardens
- Xcel Energy supported the legislation
- Xcel Submitted the program plan for approval in Sept. 2013
- The program is on track to begin accepting applications within 90 days of final plan approval
- Developing collaborative workshops with the solar industry and the commission

Program Benefits

- Designed to provide more customers with the opportunity to purchase renewable energy
- Makes solar available to renters and property owners with shaded/unsuitable sites
- Assists in meeting the MN Solar Energy Standard
- Provides economic value to the state

Terms

CSG Operator

Developer/manager/owner of the CSG

Subscriber

End customer that receives the bill credit

Subscription

Allocation of energy produced that goes to the subscriber

Bill Credit

The monthly payment for the energy produced that is received on the subscribers bill

Unsubscribed energy

The energy not allocated to subscribers

NSPM's Program Overview (legislated)

- Garden capacity limited to 1 MV
- Subscription minimum is 200\d/tts
- Subscription maximum is 120% of annual consumption (based on prior 2 years)
- Subscriber must reside within county or contiguous county
- Gardens must have 5 subscribers
- No single subscriber can be allocated more than 40% of garden capacity

NSPM's Program Overview - Pending

- Subscriber bill credits equal to applicable retail (~\$0.12)
- RECs are sold at an addition to the applicable retail rate
 - \$0.02 system size >250 MV
 - \$0.03 system size <=250 kV
- Gardens are eligible for incentives (but do not receive the additional REC):
 - Solar*Rewards
 - MiM
- Standard contract term between Xcel and CSG operator is 25 years

NSPM's Program Overview – Pending (Cont'd)

- Unlimited capacity first ready first served through application process
- Subscribers are protected through operator requirements, disclosures, and deposits
- Fees (per project)
 - Application Fee \$1,200
 - Deposit \$100 per M(refundable upon completion)
 - Engineering Review Fee varies depending on system requirements
 - Annual Participation Fee \$300 (for software license, etc.)
 - Monthly Metering Fee \$5.50 for 1 phase / \$8.00 for 3 phase

NSPM's Program Overview – Pending (Cont'd)

- Unused monthly bill credits are banked and rolled over until an annual payout at the applicable retail rate occurs.
- Unsubscribed energy is paid to the CSG operator at the avoided cost rate for gardens >40 kV and the applicable retail rate for gardens <40 kV
- Apply on Website at www.xcelenergy.com, upon which you will receive a username and password to the application system

Moving Forward

- Order should be made public this week
- Xcel files compliance plan with D.O.C. within 30 days of order
- D.O.C. approves and gives to P.U.C.
- P.U.C gives notice of approval
- Xcel has 90 days to launch program
- Xcel has 180 days to be ensure billing system can issue bill credits

How ItWrks-Subscriber Bill Credits

- Receive monthly production credit on electric bill
 - Expressed in dollars as a bill line item
 - = customer's share of garden MM production x applicable retail rate + REC
 - Determined annually and posted online in tariff
 - Production is credited on the following months bill
- Total share in gardens can be no greater than 120% of their usage from previous 24 months
 - 120% rule is calculated once at the time the allocation amount is entered in the system or when allocation changes
