Home and business owners in Greater Minneapolis-St. Paul have an opportunity to take advantage of low solar pricing through this limited-time Solar Twin Cities Group Purchasing Program. October 31, 2018 is the deadline to signup.

HOW DOES SOLAR **GROUP PURCHASING WORK?**

Solar Twin Cities brings residents and business owners together to deploy solar in their community affordably.

- 1. **INSTALLER SELECTION:** An advisory team solicited and selected TruNorth Solar through a competitive bid process to ensure quality work at a lower price for all customers. TruNorth Solar was selected based on past performance, level of experience, and cost.
- 2. EDUCATION: Attend a FREE Solar Power Hour educational session hosted across the Twin Cities Metro to help neighbors better understand the value proposition of owning solar, group buy pricing, solar technology, financial incentives, and the group buy process from site assessment to installation.
- **3. REDUCED PRICE:** A solar group buy lowers costs through the power of volume purchasing. The more homeowners and commercial property owners participate, the lower the cost will be for everyone. Beyond demand aggregation, group buys educate consumers and generate leads early in the process, saving both installer and purchaser time and money.
- 4. ENROLLMENT: Interested participants will receive a free, no-obligation site assessment from the selected installer. After receiving the free cost estimate, residents decide whether or not to move forward with the solar installation. October 31, 2018 is the deadline to signup.
